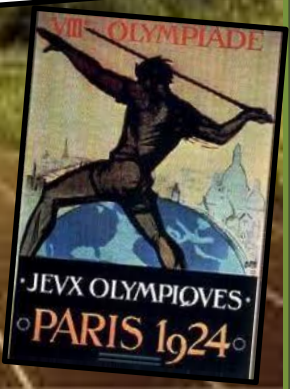
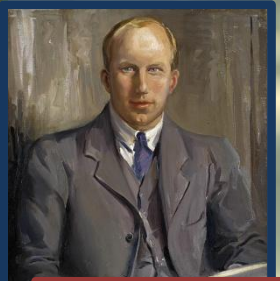


Eric Liddell

"We are all missionaries. Wherever we go we either bring people nearer to Christ or we repel them from Christ." - Eric Liddell

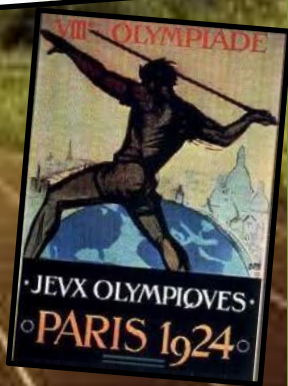
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In 1925, Liddell left behind the fame and glory of athletics and returned to China as a missionary. When the Japanese invaded China in 1937, Liddell was taken to Weihsien Internment Camp where he became known as "Uncle Eric". He continued to spread the Gospel there until he died from a brain tumor 5 months before the end of WWII. During the 2008 Beijing Olympics, the Chinese government released documents that England had sought a prisoner exchange for Liddell, but the Scotsman gave his place to a pregnant woman instead.

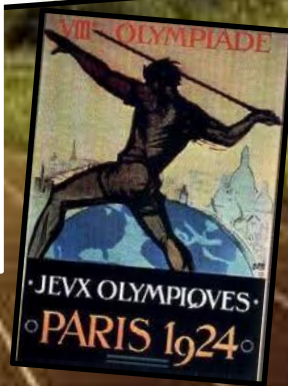

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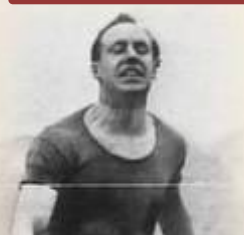
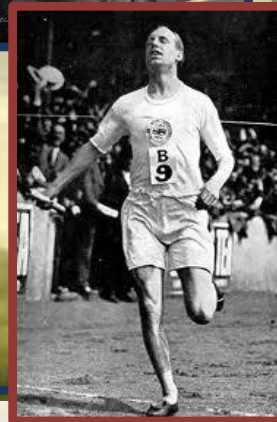


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
